(S) [RICHARD BREED] of [Interarmco] (ph) to [GINA SWIGERT], saying (S)  
that he received a telephone call from [Jakarta] this (S)  
morning and they are really pressing for the license. (S)  
[SWIGERT] said she has no info, that [BREED] probably knows (S)  
more about the situation than anyone else. [BREED] advised (S)  
that she would probably hear from the police authorities (S)  
there ([Jakarta]) in about five days. [BREED] then requested (S)
