DE 919-C\* advised on 12/13/63, that according to RIP KOURY, CURTIS LEWIS is currently with an individual by the name of ART NICK (phonetic) and LEWIS is booking his own operation. According to KOURY, ART bought five cases of books (possibly "K" books) from ABDGO. Informant also stated that according to KOURY, ROBERT BUSH gives lay-offs to LEWIS as well as LLOYD DOBBS.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the agent to whom the case on CURTIS LEWIS is assigned should have DE 370-C-TE contacted to determine the full name of the individual ABDGO, who is handling "K" books at the present.
