PETER VITALE had tryed to get him to leave at which time, HANDRINOS took a swing at VITALE and there was considerable trouble, several people tyed to hit him and they were unable to knock him out until PETER the waiter pulled a blackjack and hit him over the head with it.

According to the Informant, ANTHONY ZERILLI thought that they should take care of HANDRINOS; however, he did not feel that they should shoot him because he has been talking to an FBI Agent and also has gone to the police looking for a warrant.

According to the Informant, ANTHONY GIACALONE thought that maybe they should throw him down some stairs and that would take care of him.

According to the Informant, LOUIE LA HOOD had worked HANDRINOS over real good but could not knock him out.
