ADMINISTRATIVE: (CONT'D)

Detectives GERALD LANGTON and JAMES FALLACE, Central Intelligence Bureau (CIB), NYCPD, who are contacted on a continuing basis as they investigate criminal violations of labor matters, were contacted during August and September, 1964.

They advised that nothing new has been learned of the affairs of Local 707 due to their Bureau being placed on full time investigation of racial problems in the New York City area.

LANGTON stated that it is hoped that these matters will be ended shortly and they can resume their duties of investigating labor matters.

FALLACE advised that the slates of various groups should be appearing by September, in preparation for the fall elections this year.

They advised that they will be in touch with SA SULLIVAN upon their resumption of their regular duties.

The following informants were contacted during July and August, 1964, and could provide no current pertinent information of the affairs of Local 707 or its officials:

Regarding the attempts to interview SALVATORE D'EORIO as set out in the details of this report, D'EORIO was telephonically contacted on two of these occasions and arrangements were made for an interview. D'EORIO failed to appear as was arranged in each instance. Additional attempts are being made to interview D'EORIO, as it is felt he possesses knowledge which would be valuable to this investigation.

ADMINISTRATIVE : (CONT'D)

It will be noted that NY 4318-C, who is NY T-1 in the details of this report, is a close friend of FRANK CONNOLLY, former official of Local 707 and mentioned also in the details of this report.

NY 4318-C is endeavoring to persuade CONNOLLY to cooperate with the FBI in bringing to light shakedowns and other matters relative to Local 707.

In a meeting between the informant and CONNOLLY during July, 1964, CONNOLLY indicated a desire to cooperate with the FBI, but several confusing issues concerning control of the union have arisen and he (CONNOLLY) did not desire to talk to anyone just yet.

This matter is being followed closely with the informant so that CONNOLLY will be interviewed at the most advantageous time in an attempt to obtain his fullest cooperation.
