Informant also advised on this date that he had obtained \$100,000 from <u>FAT TONY! PALERNO</u> in the form of an interest free the loan which money was to be used by ANTHONY RUSSO.

Also on 3/3/64, informant related that the subject was intending to sell his home in Englewhold Cliffs, New Jersey, and although it is worth \$100,000, the subject would take as little as \$62,000 for it just to get his money out of the country. EBOLI stated that he would take this money along with \$30,000 or \$35,000 that he has in AT&T stock, and place it possibly in a bank in Nassau where it could earn him 6 or 7% interest. His concern centered around the fact, that according to the informant, he was being audited by Internal Revenue Service for the years 1960 and 1961 and feared that the Government would put a lien on his money. He was heard to make a remark that "any minute something is going to cave in."
