LABOR MANAGEMENT RELATIONS ACT 1947

Enclosed herewith is a self explanatory letterhead memorandum containing information furnished on 10/17/61, by HUGH E. SHERIDAN, Chairman, New York Trucking Authority, 141 Broadway, New York City, who requested his identity not be disclosed.

INFORMANT

Files of the NYO contain numerous references to S.G.S. Associates, HARRY SALTZSTEIN, ANTHONY PROVENZANO, SIGMOND J. BROVARSKI and ALFRED REGER. REGER was found guilty on 6/5/57, of three counts of extortion, NY 122-524 and 122-526, and is currently under indictment in New York County on a four count extortion violation NY 159-35.

This matter was discussed with AUSA KELLY, EDNY on 10/18/61, and he stated that the consultant fees paid to S.G.S. Associates do not appear to constitute a violation of the LMRA statute, even if it could be proven that part of this fee is being used to enable the companies to continue operating. He stated he does not feel that this matter warrants further investigation.
