RUSSELL L. WOOD, ONE OF GOODHUE'S MAGAZINE SOLICITORS WHO WAS THEN THE SON-IN-LAW OF LAD FELIX, OPERATOR OF THE MAYFLOWER HOTEL. GOODHUE WAS AGAIN INTERVIEWED BY DENVER AGENT ON DECEMBER 24, 1969, AT WHICH TIME HE WAS STILL RESIDING AT 1295 ZENOBIA, DENVER, AND CONTINUING HIS ACTIVITIES AS A MANAGER OF MAGAZINE SOLICITATION CREWS OPERATION THROUGHOUT THE UNITED STATES. AT THAT TIME HE STATED HE WAS STILL MAKING PAYMENTS ON THE OLD GAMBLIN DEBT TO CLARENCE SMALDONE AND PAUL VILLANO AT THE RATE OF \$100 PER WEEK.

ON JUNE 13, 1972, DN 831-PC REPORTED GOODHUE WAS CONTINUING TO PERATE THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY AS A DIRECTOR OF SALES CREWS FOR CONTINENTAL READER'S SERVICE, MICHIGAN CITY, INDIANA, OPERATED BY WALTER LAKE AND HIS SON, WALTER LAKE, JR. THIS INFORMANT REPORTED GOODHUE REPORTEDLY WAS OPERATING ALSO AS A MONEY LENDER AND WAS SUSPECTED OF BEING INVOLVED IN PROSTITUTION ACTIVITIES. HE WAS DESCRIBED BY THE INFORMANT AS A CLOSE FRIEND OF LAD FELIX OF THE MAYFLOWER HOTEL, AND DENVER ATTORNEY ALBERT NORBONT.
