This is in further response to your May 12th inquiry on behalf of Mr. Pete Johnson. Mr. Johnson requests your support of legislation that, as you are aware, was recently introduced in both the Senate and the House regarding the release of all Government files pertaining to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

0 Assassination Materials Disclosure Act of 1992
In an effort to be of possible assistance in responding to your constituent's concern, I am enclosing a copy of Director Sessions' remarks before the Senate Committee on Governmental Affairs on May 12th regarding the Assassination Materials Disclosure Act, Senate Joint Resolution 282. You will note in reading that Director Sessions supports the maximum disclosure under the law of information pertaining to President Kennedy's assassination. You will also note his assurance that the FBI will work cooperatively through the Department of Justice with both the Senate and the House to develop a comprehensive approach to these important issues.

I hope this information will assist you in responding to Mr. Johnson.
