The purpose of this memo is to bring you up-to-date on our progress in reviewing FBI case files relating to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy that came into the hands of the House Select Committee on Assassinations.

Under the terms of the Kennedy Assassination Materials Disclosure Act, we are required to complete an identification aid for each document in the FBI case files and to obtain the FBI's approval for release of the documents. As you may recall, George Chalou, Deputy Director of the NARA JFK Task Force, and Mary Henderson of your staff, reviewed the JFK case file and concluded that the materials we were reviewing appeared to be exact duplicates of what the Bureau released under FOIA. Absent a statement from the Bureau that the JFK case file transferred to the House Select Committee on Assassinations is disclosable because it is an exact copy of the case file released under FOIA, we plan to begin delivery to the Bureau next week of 11,519 completed identification aid forms associated with the 43 boxes or records that comprise the JFK case file. Approximately two weeks later, we expect to deliver a comparable number of identification aid forms for the Lee Harvey Oswald case file. The JFK data collection database will show that all of these documents are closed, pending completion of a FBI review.

As you know, we have some 30 boxes of FBI documents that comprise the Jack Ruby case file. We estimate that there will be approximately 7,500 completed identification forms. The Ruby case file poses unusual problems because there are two versions, one of which appears to be nothing more than a copy of FOIA released material. The second version is identified as "Committee Staff" and appears to have fewer redactions than the FOIA released material. We consider each version different and we are preparing separate identification aid forms for the documents in each version.

It appears that the work load of both the FBI and NARA can be reduced significantly if the Bureau certifies that the FBI case files in our custody (excluding the second version of the Jack Ruby

case file) are in fact exact copies of documents previously released by the Bureau under FOIA. This would eliminate the need for NARA to print out two copies of the identification forms and relieve the Bureau of reviewing more than 20,000 identification forms.

I am very interested in obtaining as soon as possible the Bureau's certification in writing that the case files (except for the second version of the Jack Ruby case file) are disclosable because they are exact copies of material the FBI previously released to the public under FOIA. Please advise me when I might expect a decision from the Bureau. We plan to commence delivery of completed identification forms on Friday, June 11, 1993. However, receipt of the above mentioned written certification would obviate this.

I should note that this proposed arrangement applies only to FBI case files. We have encountered numerous FBI documents in the numbered House Select Committee on Assassination records that must be referred to the Bureau for authorization to disclose them. It will be a week or so before I can give you a preliminary estimate of how many documents this will entail.
