Synopsis: To assist in the searches for the core and related subjects as more specific instructions were set forth in the 7/8/98 EC from OPCA, captioned as above.

Details: Kansas City conducted a new indices search for any additional assassination related information that may have been placed on record since the previous search not to include the prior responses to this legislation. Kansas City conducted a separate search for the core and the related subjects, with negative results.

Kansas City also checked with the SAC's secretary for any old "archived" material and an E-mail message was sent to every employee in the Kansas City Division, with negative results.

Kansas City will forward search slips to FBIHQ via Bureau mail.
