Based on data furnished by the Records Section and compiled by the Executive Branch Agencies Unit (EBAU), 168,768 name check communications falling within the responsibilities of this unit were received during the month of March, 1979, and a total of 176,579 (including pending submissions carried over from the previous month) were processed. A total of 29,266 forms, as well as 850 telephonic requests, were directly handled by review clerks and analysts of the EBAU. In connection with this work, 9,779 files were received for review purposes; 1,035 copies of reports were disseminated to appropriate agencies; 1,301 file references were made; and 138 memoranda were prepared by analysts. A total of 28,420 checks were determined to be "No Record." The remaining name checks relating to the work of the EBAU which were processed during the month and determined in the Records Section to be "No Record" were processed by this Unit for transmittal to the submitting agencies.

Enclosed are copies of more specific (by requester) breakdowns of the work of the EBAU for March, 1979.



Based on data furnished by the Records Section and compiled by the Executive Branch Agencies Unit (EBAU), 190,870 name check communications falling within the responsibilities of this unit were received during the month of April, 1979, and a total of 170,360 (including pending submissions carried over from the previous month) were processed. A total of 32,941 forms, as well as 595 telephonic requests, were directly handled by review clerks and analysts of the EBAU. In connection with this work, 8,387 files were received for review purposes; 957 copies of reports were disseminated to appropriate agencies; 1,281 file references were made; and 138 memoranda were prepared by analysts. A total of 27,612 checks were determined to be "No Record." The remaining name checks relating to the work of the EBAU which were processed during the month and determined in the Records Section to be "No Record" were processed by this Unit for transmittal to the submitting agencies.
