Synopsis: The JFK Task Force (JFKTF) is relocating to room 11144 by mid July 1997. Due to the sensitive records maintained by the JFKTF, a card key reader is being requested for access to room 11144.

Details: The JFKTF is relocating to room 11144 by mid July 1997. The nature of the JFKTF work requires maintenance of over 200 file cabinets of FBI records including Special File Room and Personnel records. The JFKTF maintains a large volume of classified records as well as its own sensitive indices for research purposes.

Due to the JFKTF having a personnel count of 70 employees and the impracticality of an employee watching the entrance at all times, a card reader is being requested for the entrance to room 11144.
