Details: In referenced communication, each field office was requested to search for additional records related to the JFK assassination, as well as, search any and all office space, storage areas, or archived material for any materials related to the assassination. This communication resulted in questions about the extent of the search.

Each field office should exhaust every possible avenue to locate both newly created material and any pre-JFK Records Collection Act material that may not have been located in prior searches, including the subjects listed as 'core and related subjects'. Any and all indices should be searched (not an updated search) and the search slips, both negative and positive should be forwarded to the Historical and Executive Review Unit/JFK Task Force. Any material surfaced through this new search should be noted in the responsive EC as material not previously accounted for in the prior search and the originals forwarded to the JFK Task Force immediately.

To assist in the search for the "core and related subjects", biographical data is being furnished which should assist you. Please expand the search to include "Presidential Assassination Threats of JFK prior to 11/63".
