A search of Norfolk Division manual and automated indices revealed the following:

The name JFK Conspiracy is referenced to Norfolk file 80-0-1059, which is a public relations control file. Referenced serial is FBIHQ teletype to All field Offices, 04/14/1992, entitled, "Media Matters: Fox Telecast Re: JFK Conspiracy, 04/15/1992." (Serial 1059 is not enclosed.)

The names John F. Kennedy Assassination and Lee Harvey Oswald are referenced to Norfolk file 89-17. This file, consisting of two volumes, was shipped to FBIHQ, William Shackelford, Room 4336, FOIPA, via referenced Norfolk airtel, 04/30/1992. One indices card for this reference is attached hereto.

The name Assassination of President Kennedy is referenced to Norfolk file 175-4. Pursuant to Bureau guidelines, this file was destroyed 03/13/1978. One indices card for this reference is attached hereto.

The name John F. Kennedy, President, is referenced to Norfolk file 105-00-107. Serial 107 as well as one indices card are attached hereto.

In regard John F. Kennedy Assassination; John F. Kennedy Assassination, Dallas; John F. Kennedy Assassination, New Orleans; Lee Harvey Oswald, Dallas; Lee Harvey Oswald, New Orleans; Marina Oswald, Dallas; Marina Oswald, New Orleans; Jack Ruby; Jack Leon Ruby, Dallas, New Orleans; and Warren Commission there is one reference each in Norfolk control file 190-2-87. These names appear on a listing of preprocessed FOIPA material available for review at FBIHQ (FBIHQ airtel to All Field Offices, 02/20/1979). Ten indices cards for these references are attached hereto. (Serial 87 is not enclosed.)

In regard to Lee Harvey Oswald and Jack Leon Ruby, there is one reference each in Norfolk file 44-148. Pursuant to Bureau guidelines, this file was destroyed 05/24/1973. Two indices cards for these references are attached hereto. This information was reported in referenced Norfolk teletype, 01/27/1992.
