Details: Per referenced EC, and telcal between Catherine Lamey, FBIHQ and PLS Denise L. Kuborn, AQ, dated 7/30/98, Albuquerque has conducted a new search of its manual and automated indices on John F. Kennedy, Lee Harvey Oswald, Jack Ruby, Marguerite Oswald, Marina Oswald, Ruth Hyde Paine, Michael Ralph Paine, George de Mohrenschildt, Clay Shaw, and David Ferrie. Also searched were the various aka's for these subjects. Albuquerque does not have any micro computer indices. Albuquerque was unable to conduct a search of the ISIS system. The individuals with access to this system will be out of the division until 08/10/1998. Headquarters does have access to this system and it would be more time efficient for this search to be conducted at HQ rather than waiting for the Albuquerque analyst to return.

During the search, Albuquerque located for index cards which were previously sent to the Bureau with Albuquerque EC dated 07/16/1998.

Enclosed for the Bureau are 10 FD-160 search slips.
