The Spanish and Portuguese agencies which furnished information to the FBI regarding the assassination of President Kennedy no longer exist in their respective governments. Legat contact with the present government agencies who assumed similar duties resulted in the following:

Subsequent to referenced telcall, Legat contact at the Spanish agency which assumed present day responsibilities stated in their opinion Spanish government information, whether classified or not as per previous practices, should not be made available to the public.

Contact with the Portuguese military agency assuming present day responsibility was effected by Legat Madrid. The Portuguese agency is of the opinion their classified/non-classified information, being Portuguese government information, should not be declassified or made available to the public by the FBI.
