**Synopsis:** Eleven (11) volumes of 62-NO-3395 consolidated in 100-20176 entitle "Minutemen" being shipped by separate cover under this communication.

**Reference:** JFK Task Force EC to New Orleans dated 9/24/96 entitled as captioned above. Telephone conversation between Brian Fields JFK Task Force and CDC Warren B. Jung, II on 10/2/96 pertaining to the entitled matter.

**Details:** Pursuant to instructions set out in the referenced communications, Ms Brenda M. Thompson, Paralegal Specialist (PLS), determined that New Orleans file # 62-NO-3395 had been consolidated into 100-NO-20176 entitled "Minutemen" and consisted of eleven (11) volumes. PLS Thompson assisted by Elsur File Assistants Celeste Varnado and Kristine Majnerick reviewed all the serials in volumes five (5) through (11) of this file (see ADM section) for any Elsur information. Several names mentioned in volumes 5-11 were checked in the Elsur indices with negative results. The original files for 62-NO-3395 (consolidated into 100-NO-20176) are being duplicated and will be forwarded to JFK Task Force under cover of this communications.
