Synopsis: Washington Field Office is requested to send responsive material to FBIHQ/JFK Task Force as soon as possible.

Details: In 1992, Congress mandated all agencies to process records related to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy. The FBI has been working with the Assassination Records Review Board (the Board) since their inception. The material requested is needed for the FBI to be in compliance with the Act.

The Act also mandates that all original assassination records will be made available to the public at the National Archives and Records Administration. Therefore, any records requested from your office should be copied, since the originals will not be returned.
