Details: Manual and FOIMS searches of the Dallas Office were conducted to determine if there was any information or original documents concerning the below-listed items:

- 1. "Radio Operator Logs"
- 2. "No. 1 and No. 2 Registers" for the date of the assassination
- 3. "Lee Harvey Oswald Note" and any additional investigation of the "Note"

Radio Operator David Howard advised radio operator logs are destroyed after one year, and to his knowledge, the Dallas Office is not maintaining any regarding the assassination.

SAS-C Teddie Degelia, who has served in the Dallas Office since 1963, and AO Glenda Rupprath, who has served in the Dallas Office since 1964, advised that to their knowledge, all original JFK related information was shipped to FBIHQ approximately three years ago. Neither Ms. Degelia nor Ms. Rupprath had any knowledge regarding the location of Radio
