Title: PHONES LINES FOR THE JFK TASK FORCE

Synopsis: Due to the relocation of the JFK Task Force to the 11th floor, phone lines will need to be relocated for 70-75 employees and 5 new phone lines will need to be installed by May 15, 1997.

Enclosure: List of current phone extensions requested to be relocated.

Details: The JFK Task Force will be relocating to room 11144, by May 15, 1997. A total of 70-75 employees will be relocating from the JFK Task Force and the Freedom of Information/Privacy Acts (FOIPA) Section to room 11144. Two facsimile lines will also have to be relocated, one of which is a secure line.

It is requested that existing phone lines be relocated to room 11144. New lines will need to be installed for 5 employees that do not have existing phone lines. Single line phones are requested. A list of employees and their respective lines is attached.

Currently, all existing lines assigned to the JFK Task Force are single lines. It is requested that a Nartel Meridian Digital phone be installed for the Unit Chief, 2 Deputy Unit Chiefs and a secretary.

Several feature changes will be necessary, including call pick up groups. Pursuant to telephonic communication with Pat Carson, these changes will be verified at a later date.

Facsimile machines will also be relocated to room 11144. The secure facsimile number is 324-9471. The regular facsimile number is 324-3409.
