**Details:** (U) Reference OPCA EC to Legat, Bern and other receiving Legats, dated 6/19/98; telephone conversation between ALAT David A. Maniquis, Legat, Bern and Carol Keeley, OPCA, Historical and Executive Review Unit (HERU), on 7/8/98.

(U) In referenced telephone conversation, it was explained that certain documents transmitted to Legat, Bern with referenced EC will require an additional letter from the Director and the Review Board in that they were provided by a different Swiss police service than the others in the enclosure. In order for Legat, Bern to satisfy HERU's request to handle the release request in an expeditious manner, this packet of letters is still needed.
