AFTER THE DEATH OF FORMER DIRECTOR HOOVER, ASAC SULLIVAN, IN A MEMORANDUM TO INSPECTOR HELGESON EXPLAINED THE PROCESS HE DEVISED IN CATALOGING THE MATERIAL CONTAINED IN THE CABINETS IN HOOVER'S OFFICE.
