Synopsis: Results of searches within Sacramento Division.

Administrative: Delay in reporting from the Sacramento Division was due to difficulty in locating two closed files containing information relative to the assassination of President Kennedy.

Enclosures: Enclosed for the Bureau are indices search slips and an original letter from an anonymous writer who claims to be JFK's daughter.

Details: Searches of Sacramento indices revealed three files relating to the Kennedy assassination: 62-HQ-1029205; 175-0 (Serial 191); and 89-0 (Serial 206). The first two files listed did not contain any new material; however, the 89-0-206 serial (original enclosed) was received at this office in October, 1997, and has not been accounted for previously.
