Details: By EC dated 5/29/98, field offices were requested to conduct new indices searches for any additional assassination related information that may have been placed on record since the previous search.

On 6/8/98, SU conducted a search of its indices and determined that no new assassination related information had been placed on record since the last search was conducted. It was also determined that there was no "archived" SAC material relating to the assassination.
