190-0-serials 1543 was identified. It had been previously permanently charged out to "Record Disposition and Archival Unit" (No copy maintained by NK) in 1990.

80-648 is a control file for Liaison with United States Secret Service (USSS.) There are three volumes of same and a review determined that nothing had been indexed regarding LEE HARVEY OSWALD. Two index cards located in General Indices reflected a stamp which referred to 80-648, a Secret Service liaison file. These are printed cards of unknown origin, and reflected the use of aka LEE HARVEY OSWALD by EDWARD JOSEPH PATTERSON, DOB - 2/8/48, POB, Camden, New Jersey, Social Security Number - 148-40-6255. No file can be located in Newark re this. Records Supervisor Phyllis Ricks advised she had no knowledge of origin of and further advised there was no additional indexing to 80-648. She surmised that they had been sent to FBI, NK by USSS.

Regarding LEE HARVEY OSWALD and MARINA OSWALD -

File 105-15291, Volumes I and II, constituting entire file, were also sent to "RECORD DISPOSITION AND ARCHIVAL UNIT," no date reflected, no copy maintained by NK.

NK has therefore, previously provided all information regarding captioned matter.
