Dallas T-1 of instant report on 12/17/56, advised that the only CP members who have attended meetings or participated in the affairs of the Dallas Chapter of the GI Forum during the past year, were 3 individuals. For information of the Bureau, these 3 individuals named by informant are DL-2-S, DL-15-S, and DL-6-S. Inasmuch as the only CP infiltration in the Dallas Chapter of instant organization during the past several months has been only by Bureau informants, it is not believed that further investigation concerning this matter is warranted. It is noted, however, that these Bureau informants attended functions of instant organization in Dallas occasionally in accord with their instructions from their CP leader, AUGUSTIN ESTRADA.
