2:35 am [WF 800-S] (S) YURI V. KALASHNIKOV to SERGEY SERGEEVICH (MALOV?) (S) AMTORG, NYC, (S) advising that he (S) [EVGENI S. SHERSHNEV] (S) his wife and child had planned on leaving this morning about 6 am but he thinks that they departed about 7 am. They were in two cars and were accompanied by the chauffeur and VLADIMIR V. KULINICH (S) They will be in New York about 12 noon and will take their things directly to the pier. Their ship leaves tomorrow and they will probably stay at the Henry Hudson Hotel and will call [MALOV] (S) for sure. (Russian) (S) wbw

9:38 am [WF 279-S] (S) VITAUTAS M. ZENKEVICHYUS to JULIUS HORTON, Union Tourse, NY (S) stating that he was calling about the tickets he requested. (No indication if tickets were for ZENKEVICHYUS or another Soviet) (S) HORTON told ZENKEVICHYUS (S) that they were on the way and would be there tomorrow. HORTON asked if NIKOLAI G. REZNICHENKO (S) was in Wash. and ZEN told him he hadn't seen REZ (S) and thought REZ was still in NY. OK, then tickets will be sent to ZEN in ZEN's name at the Decatur St. address. OK. (No date given for travel but indication was given that the tickets are for travel to Moscow via Paris.) (S)
