Contact with trustworthy law enforcement officers of the intelligence squads of the Dallas PD and Dallas SO, and with reliable informants (DL 170-C, DL 141-C, DL 247-C and DL 185-C-TE) concerning the subject and his activities and associates have been made, and each source has advised that although CAMPISI continues his close association with numerous known gamblers and with JOSEPH FRANCIS CIVELLO, there is no indication that CAMPISI is criminally involved in any matter at the present time.

The identification of telephones available to CAMPISI at his residence and his place of business has been made, and a request has been made of the telephone company in Dallas to obtain toll calls charged to these telephones. When this is received, if appropriate, leads concerning these toll calls will be set out by Dallas. It is also noted that CAMPISI has only been arrested once in his life, that being on 7/29/44, as previously reported.

Upon receipt and review of toll calls charged to CAMPISI, a report will be submitted by Dallas with recommendations either for further investigation or that the matter does not warrant any further investigation.
