It is noted that investigative period of this report predates that of references report inasmuch as results of investigation was not received at time referenced report was prepared.

DL 135-C-TE was contacted on August 24, 1970, by SA WILLIAM B. HOLLOMAN and furnished the following information:

During a conversation with JOE CAMPISI on 8/23/70, he commented concerning the appointment of a Sheriff for Dallas County to replace Sheriff BILL DECKER, recently deceased. CAMPISI indicated he is strongly in favor of CLARENCE JONES, DECKER's assistant, and the one chosen to replace DECKER. CAMPISI also discussed the possibility of an appointment of Assistant Chief FISHER, Dallas PD, and indicated that he did not like FISHER and was opposed to his appointment. From conversation with CAMPISI, it appears that CAMPISI has a feeling that if CLARENCE ~~JONES~~ TEXAS is appointed Sheriff, CAMPISI and other bookmakers associates with him will be able to operate in Dallas County with no problems and for this reason is strongly in favor of JONES.
