Re Dallas letter to Bureau, 4/9/65.

On 4/8, 13, 22, 30/65, JOHN ELI STONE (DL 162-37), was contacted by Bureau Agents at his place of business, a restaurant, as part of a planned approach being used by the Dallas Office to cultivate STONE as either a source or as an informant. STONE has been described previously as one of the biggest bookmaking contacts throughout the United States. STONE continues to be cordial and friendly to the Bureau Agents and continues to furnish small bits of information during these discussions about gambling matters, about his own background and activities, and about the gambling activities of other Dallas area gamblers. STONE has repeatedly expressed his deep respect for the FBI. Contacts of STONE, along the lines set out above, will be conducted.

On 5/6/65, efforts were made by Bureau Agents to contact RICHARD MELVIN (DL 166-124) and WILLIAM RAY DAVIS (DL 162-264). The names of these two well known Dallas area gamblers, along with their addresses and phone numbers had been found by local authorities at Las Vegas, Nevada, in the personal effects of LOUIS PAREES following his death in the desert area near Las Vegas on 4/13/65. PAREES had been shot
