WEEKLY SUMMARY

By airtel 3/6/62, New Haven advised information received from PCI LOUIS KALETSKY that PCI had received advance information 2/27/62 from Bridgeport, Conn. gambler EUGENE ROLLERI, to bet on SMU, a five point favorite in game played 2/27/62 at Waco, Texas against Baylor which SMU won by 17 points. ROLLERI told PCI this was a "larceny game" meaning game was fixed and officials had been reached. (Game refereed by KEN PRYOR and BO MCALISTER. According to DL-144-C* SMU opened as 8 point favorite and closed as 9 point favorite). New Haven PCI advised that ROLLERI's source for this information unknown to PCI but believed to be big better in New Jersey.
