The current Galveston, Texas, telephone directory reflects Telephone Number SO 3-2037 is listed to JOE LERNER, 4316 Caduces Street, Galveston, Texas. The 1966 Galveston telephone directory also reflects this number was listed to LERNER.

On July 15, 1968, Captain ROY KELLER, Galveston Police Department, advised he has known JOE LERNER for several years stating LERNER resides in Galveston and operates the Starr Furniture Company at Texas City, Texas.
