Reference is made to the letter from Miami to Pittsburgh and from Pittsburgh to Miami, both dated March 14, 1947. Upon receipt of the memorandum attached to the letter from Pittsburgh, Confidential Informant SP-3 was contacted on March 21, 1947, and he suggested that two of the possible participants in this attempted swindle were WILLIAM DOCKERY, alias SULLIVAN, FBI # 147037, BCM-6, and JOSEPH SRIMES, alias "The String Kid of Sioux City, Iowa," FBI # 637777. Informant stated that these two confidence men are known to have made a score somewhere in Pennsylvania the past summer. He also stated that several confidence men originate out of Steubenville, Ohio, where they are said to have the town fixed.
