Medlevine is the son of Abe Medlevine. Maurice Medlevine was born on March 22, 1911, and was the holder of United States Passport Number Z1216996. Prior to the use of this passport, Medlevine travelled to Israel in the possession of U. S. Passport Number K1628623. He entered Israel on April 18, 1970, and departed May 20, 1970. He again entered Israel on July 15, 1970, and departed July 18, 1970. Medlevine entered Israel for the third time on December 14, 1970, and there is no record of his departure.

Medlevine was granted a temporary residence visa and issued an Israeli Identification Card.
