Mr. Bächler sent the check to the Swiss People's Bank in Bern to have it cashed.

He received a reply to the effect that the check could not be cashed on account of insufficient funds.

Mr. Bächler was the victim of a fraud perpetrated by hotel guest. Leo Ogul because of insufficient funds.

Based upon the above facts, a criminal complaint has been filed against Leo Ogul on charges of fraud under the provisions of the above legislation.
