## ADMINISTRATIVE

This case was carried in a Pending Inactive status until the apprehension of OGUL on 5/4/72, in New York. The matter has been pending prosecution since this date.

Legat, Tel Aviv advised by letter dated 5/24/72, that a stop has been placed in the files of the Israeli National Police against any departure by MEDLEVINE from Israel.

The Legat, Tel Aviv has been requested by separate communication to verify MEDLEVINE's residence in Tel Aviv.

LA 5040-C-TE advised on 5/23/72, that according to LEO OGUL, both he and MEDLEVINE had become citizens of Israel, and MEDLEVINE had changed his name to a Jewish name. Chicago advised by letter dated 6/21/72, that CG 6830-C in April, 1972 advised that a month previously he had received a letter from MEDLEVINE from Tel Aviv, Israel. The return address reflected a post office box number unrecalled by the informant. In the letter, MEDLEVINE stated that someone in the United States was working on his case and that he was looking forward to returning to the United States as he was miserable in Israel. The informant said he threw the letter away.
