On 7/14/67, former LV 211-PC was contacted by SAC DEAN W. ELSON at his request at which time source indicated he wanted to inform SAC ELSON of several developments involving the Stardust Hotel, Las Vegas, Nevada, which will not be made known publicly for 30 to 60 days.

NEVADA Source indicated that in talking with MORRIS BARNEY DALITZ, aka "Moe XDalitz, that DALITZ advised the sale of the Desert Inn Harton had been finalized and was completely wrapped up with all persons having an interest being paid off and happy. Source was aware that DALITZ knew that SAC ELSON had knowledge of a number of undisclosed interests in the Desert Inn Hotel and when source was asked whether or not this applied to everyone who had an interest in the Desert Inn, source indicated DALITZ said everyone had been paid off, that the matter had been worked out, and that everyone was "happy." Source stated that M. B. DALITZ, MORRIE KLEINMAN and SAM TUCKER, principal owners in the Stardust and former Desert Inn 51 -operation, had decided to "retire" and sever their connections with the gambling industry. Source stated that this was decided primarily based on the fact that they had acquired a 32 million dollar loan for construction at the Desert Inn and had now transferred that loan to the Stardust operation which made it possible for them to pay off their loan for the purchase of the
