Reference is made to the FBI Laboratory Transmittal Form directed here under date of 10/12/59, wherein it is suggested that "additional handwritten signatures prepared by WEINHEIMER at an extremely rapid rate of speed" might be of "some" value in identifying the questioned signatures of interest in this matter.

Further reference is made to the report of SA IAN D. MAC LENNAN dated 12/2/58 at New York reflecting that WEINHEIMER refused to submit to further interview in this matter upon contact.

In the light of WEINHEIMER's attitude, efforts to obtain rapidly written signatures from him will not be undertaken unless directed by the Bureau.
