Dear Mr. Hoover:

On February 10, 1960, Edward F. Weinheimer was found guilty of eight counts of perjury committed before a Grand Jury in the District of Columbia.

In the investigation and preparation of this case we were afforded invaluable assistance from Supervisor James R. Adams whose cooperation was highly praised by the attorneys who prosecuted the case.

During the conduct of the trial Special Agent Edward W. Pennypacker of the Washington Field Office testified as a witness for the Government and his demeanor as a witness is a tribute to the Bureau. Special Agent Pennypacker also sat at the counsel table during the trial and was an invaluable aid in the preparation of the case.

I wish that you would also convey my appreciation to the many other agents in the field who participated in the investigation of this case and whose efforts made possible this successful prosecution. In particular, I wish to commend Special Agent Damon W. Pitcher of the Pittsburgh Field Office for his efficient and expeditious investigation.
