We are in receipt of a photostatic copy of a letter dated February 13, 1960, addressed to Honorable James W. Morris, United States District Court Judge, from George W. Hendrickson, #36476, New Jersey State Prison Farms, Lock Bag R, Rahway, New Jersey. According to this letter, Hendrickson requested that he be interviewed by a member of the Senate Rackets Committee as he claims that he "can be of grave importance to one of today's top problems."

The above described letter was forwarded to us by the Senate Rackets Committee for our attention. It is requested, therefore, that you interview Hendrickson regarding the information he may have as suggested in his letter.
