

NOTE ON YELLOW:

Subject's name not in Security Index. He resides Brooklyn, New York, with parents and was reported to have been in Russia during early 1961, visiting his wife, who has been refused admittance to the United States. Subject holds a fellowship with the National Science Foundation and recently received approval to study under the fellowship at Manchester, England. According to Legal Attache, London, subject has not arrived in Great Britain and Legal Attache requests information concerning present travel status. State, CIA and National Science Foundation previously furnished pertinent information concerning Greendlinger. Relet placed case in pending inactive status awaiting results of investigation in England. (u)
