Doctor BERNHARD NEUMANN. Legat, London, by letters, 6/30/61 and 7/20/61, advised there is no trace of GREENDLINGER having visited or transited the United Kingdom. Bulet, 8/18/61, requested NYO to make additional efforts to determine GREENDLINGER's present whereabouts. In view of the Bureau's request it is believed that a mail cover on GREENDLINGER's parents would be productive as to the present whereabouts of MARTIN GREENDLINGER with a minimum possibility of embarrassment to Bureau.

An additional thirty day period is being requested as the previous thirty day period has not been productive of the desired information.

On 10/24/61, the US Post Office Inspectors advised that Mr. and Mrs. D. GREENDLINGER received a 1st class foreign letter dated 10/16/61, on which the sender's name, return address, and postmark were reported as illegible. In view of fact that MARTIN GREENDLINGER could have been the sender of this letter the USPO is now being requested to forward mail tracings on illegible mail.
