Attached are ten copies of a letterhead memorandum setting forth information on instant subject, and ten copies of an evaluation memorandum. The confidential source abroad mentioned in the letterhead memorandum is [redacted] former member of the Cuban Bureau for the Repression of Communist Activities (BRAC), who is currently residing in Madrid.

OTHER 4

[redacted] stated that the information set forth in the attached memorandum was supplied to him by the wife of ROBERTO VAZQUEZ, the individual who is reported to have taken the action described in the memorandum. [redacted] said that the wife of VAZQUEZ recently arrived in Spain from Cuba.

The attached memorandum has been classified confidential to protect the source, who furnishes information of Bureau interest on Cuban matters on a continuing basis. No local dissemination was made of the attached memorandum since it does not concern Spain.

As of additional possible interest to the Bureau, there are set forth below the details of a memorandum dated 11-3-60 which was prepared by Mr. ROBERT W. ZIMMERMANN of the Embassy's Political Section. JOSE M. MAYORGA is not known to this office nor is there any background information concerning him available in the files of this office.

"José M. Mayorga telephoned this morning to say that he had just received information that the groupings of anti-Castro refugees had changed in Miami and that the opposition was reforming around the group of Colonels whom Mayorga believes to be the only group capable of
