## PROGRESS LETTER


Since referenced progress letter was submitted, the San Francisco Division has continued to follow the activities of LCN Member JIMMY FRATIANNO and others closely associated with FRATIANNO through investigation and maintaining close liaison with the San Francisco Police Department (SFPD) Intelligence Unit.

The San Francisco Division has also developed a source of information, CSSF 8678-C, at the San Francisco Hilton Hotel which is frequented by FRATIANNO and San Francisco Teamster Official RUDY THAM.

During the later part of 1976, FRATIANNO and RUDY THAM, prominent San Francisco Teamster Official, leased a clothing store located at 2076 Mission Street, San Francisco, California, for the alleged purpose of selling discount clothing. A strong possibility exists that the store is a front for illegal activities such as stolen property, etc. and the current ongoing investigation is directed at determining any illegal activities associated with the clothing store.

San Francisco Teamster Official RUDY THAM is currently under investigation by San Francisco Office and the San Francisco Strike Force for violation of Labor Management Relations Act of 1947 (SF File 122-291) in regards to his accepting gratuities at the San Francisco Hilton Hotel. 183-737-30

EX-113 <u>REC-13</u> 783-757-342 San Francisco will continue to investigation the activities of FRATIANNO, THAM, AMARENA and others looking towards violation of the RICO statutes.
