THE DAY AFTER INSTANT BANK ROBBERY INFORMANT SUPPLIED THE FOLLOWING
INFORMATION.. MIKE LA JOY WAS THE NEPHEW OF FRANK DELEGGE IN WHOSE
GARAGE THE GETAWAY CAR WAS ABANDONED. HE FURTHER ADVISED THAT LA JOY
WAS DEEPLY IN DEBT AND ON HEAVY QUOTE JUICE UNQUOTE DUE TO HIS
GAMBLING. INFORMANT ALSO ADVISED DURING THE PRECEDING WEEK OF INSTANT
ROBBERY LA JOY WAS REGULARLY MEETING WITH FRANK DELEGGE AND TWO OTHER

BY SUSPECTS AND OTHER BACKGROUND DATA. INFORMANT ALSO MAINTAINED CONTACT WITH LA JOY AFTER BANK ROBBERY KEEPING OFFICE ADVISED OF HIS WHEREABOUTS, ALTERED OFFICE TO LA JOY-S ALIBI WHICH AFTER ARREST HE ACTUALLY USED. INFORMANT ALSO STATED DELEGGE AND LA JOY ARE INVOLVED IN INSTANT ROBBERY DUE TO FACT HE WAS AWARE THAT THE MEETINGS AT THE RESTAURANT HAD TO DO WITH THEIR PLANNING A SCORE IN THE NEAR FUTURE IN THAT AREA. INFORMANT ALSO DESCRIBED PREMISES WHERE LA JOY LIVED AND ALSO DESCRIBED FIREARMS WHICH LA JOY OWNED AND WAS RECOVERED AT TIME OF ARREST. THIS INFORMANT SOLELY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE IDENTIFICATION OF LA JOY.
