Authority granted to pay CG 5913-C lump-sum total of \$500 for information he furnished which directly lead to the identification of LaJoy as a participant in this bank robbery and LaJoy's subsequent apprehension by Bureau Agents without incident.

NOTE: Captioned bank robbed of \$43,097. Clothing, masks and guns found in empty house short distance from where get-away car abandoned. Informant identified LaJoy as nephew of person owning garage where car abandoned. Informant maintained close contact with LaJoy after bank robbery keeping office advised of his whereabouts and alerted office to LaJoy's alibi which after arrest he actually used. Informant described premises where LaJoy lived and also described firearms which LaJoy owned which was recovered at time of arrest. Retel requests \$500 payment for above information. This information saved considerable Agents man-hours which would have been needed in this investigation. Informant in past has furnished very valuable information concerning criminal activities in Chicago area.
