was furnished to the Direccion General de Seguridad (Direc-
torate General of Security - DGS), Spanish National Police,
Madrid, Spain. Subsequently, pertinent data from the other
LHMs and report were also furnished to the DGS. (S)(u) per G-1On 10/16/72, the DGS advised that to date their
inquiries have failed to determine subject's possible where-
abouts in Spain. In addition, they advised that they could
develop no information concerning SAMUEL GIANCANA. The DGS
further advised that a general lookout notice has been
published in an effort to locate subject, as well as GIANCANA
