It was previously reported that subject came into Mexico on 11/17/66 by car. *(u)*

JORGE VAZQUEZ ROBLES, of the Inspection Service of the Mexican Immigration, advised in 4/67 that this entry was through Nuevo Laredo. He advised that he caused a search to be made of persons entering Mexico at Laredo as tourists on 11/17/60 and could find no information indicating that SAMUEL GIANCANA (BUfile 92-3171) entered on that date. He advised that they could locate no record identifying anyone as CAIN's companion at the time of entry. *(u)*

The following information was developed 5/10/67 by SA STEVE D. EVANS, of this office, at Panama City, Panama: *(u)*

Records in Panama indicate that SAMUEL M. GIANCANA arrived in Panama on 9/10/66 on Flight 811 of Varig indicating he planned to stay in the Hotel Panama and depart for Rio de Janeiro in four days. *(u)*

These records also show that RICHARD SCALZITTI CAIN, an American citizen; Passport No. F-935979, issued on 10/19/65 in Illinois; born 10/4/31, residence 1533 North 77th Street, also arrived in Panama from Mexico City on 9/10/66 on Flight 811 of Varig. He indicated he planned to continue on to Lima, Peru, in four days. *(u)*
