CONEIN was convicted by judgment of the Court of the Department of the Seine (Paris) on 12-23-47 and was ordered to pay to his wife, MONIQUE VEBER, a monthly sum of 8000 old francs (about \$16) for the support of her/ and two children which resulted from the marriage. never followed the orders of the court. The French Police advised that CONEIN is believed to reside at 1111 Engelside Avenue, McLean, Virginia. request investigation to verify his residence there and to determine his present situation with regard to employment and standard of living. Paris files reflect that one U. S. Army Captain 31943 LUCIEN CONEIN was mentioned in a memorandum dated 7-26-56 at Washington, D.C., captioned STUART JACK SEBORER, was; MAX SEBORER, was. It indicated that CONEIN was divorced from his wife, MONIQUE VEBER, whom he had married in 1946.
