There are enclosed a copy of Legal Attache, London, letter 11-25-60 and a copy of the enclosure thereto, also dated 11-25-60. [The information contained in this enclosure would seem to answer the questions raised in referenced letter as to subject's employment in Denmark; how he first met Vladyslav M. Abarchaline; and the date of this contact.] With respect to Marvin Kantor, it is noted that the Bureau instituted investigation on Kantor on 3-16-60 as a result of [his contact with Abarchaline in Copenhagen, Denmark, on 11-16-59]. Kantor is still abroad. Background data re Kantor is contained in the enclosed letterhead memorandum dated 10-20-60 at New York. (For your info, the sources mentioned therein are identified as: A - Selective Service records LDB, Bronx, New York; B - CIA; C - E. Mogens Jensen, Chief, Danish Security Service, Copenhagen, Denmark.) [The information received from CIA was classified Secret.] (Murray Brown, mentioned in the enclosure to the Legal Attache, London, letter was also the subject of a Bureau investigation.)

[The information contained in the enclosed Legal Attache letter and memorandum indicating that books and a periodical were passed from Abarchaline to the subject may indicate a clandestine relationship between the two.] Investigation in this case, accordingly, should be accelerated and investigative steps suggested in Manual of Instructions, Section 36 F, considered. The Bureau, however, must be consulted prior to use of confidential techniques requiring Bureau authorization. Assure that investigation is complete and thorough with all leads handled promptly. Assure that pertinent information developed in your investigation, as well as that furnished you by the SOG, is included in report form suitable for dissemination.
